CIRCUMSTANCES: On February 27, 2008, the Fort Bragg Police Department developed suspect information related to multiple theft reports that have occurred over the last month in and about the City of Fort Bragg. Officers responded to an address on N. McPherson Street to contact the suspect identified as Kimberly Washburn.

Washburn was located at the residence and a probation search was conducted. During the search, several items that were reported stolen over the last month were located. Fort Bragg Police Department located a large amount of stolen property at the residence. We will be working to identify the owners of all of the property that was located. We are asking for any victims of the recent thefts to contact the Fort Bragg Police Department at 707 964-0200 and an officer will contact you for follow-up.

Our investigation is still ongoing and we believe there are additional suspect(s) that are involved. The Fort Bragg Police Department would like to encourage the citizens of Fort Bragg to continue to secure their vehicles.

Washburn was arrested and booked into the Mendocino County jail on theft charges and possession of stolen property.
