Crime or Incident: Possession of Controlled Substances
Victim: State of California
Suspect: Joseph Gay, Chloe Ludi, and a Juvenile Male

Circumstances: On 05-01-08 at approximately 1148 hours, officers were dispatched to the area of the 300 Blk. of N. Main St., behind the Redwood Financial Services building, for a report of three subjects trespassing, and possibly smoking controlled substances.

Officers arrived and detained two males, and one female subject for trespassing. Further investigation revealed that one of the males, a juvenile, was in possession of a large amount of various types of controlled substances.

The juvenile was found to be in possession approximately 85 tabs of LSD, commonly referred to as "Acid", as well as a large amount of marijuana, and various devices used for the for consumption marijuana. The juvenile was also found to be in possession of a digital scale believed to be used for distribution and sales of those substances. The juvenile was arrested for possession of controlled substances, and possession with intent to sell.

The adult female subject identified as Chloe Ludi (12-20-88) was also found to be in possession of marijuana, as well as other substances later tested and determined to be (Psilocybin) or psychedelic mushrooms. Ludi was arrested for the possession of the substances.

The second male Joseph Gay (01-07-88) was found to be in possession of approximately 30 grams of concentrated cannabis, commonly referred to as "hash".

All three subjects were taken into custody without incident. The adults were booked and transported to the Mendocino County Adult Detention Facility, and the juvenile was booked and transported to the Mendocino Juvenile Detention Facility both located in Ukiah.
