Circumstances: On 06-11-08 at approximately 0023 (12:23 a.m.) hours, FBPD officers received an anonymous report of an adult male subject dressed in black, wearing a black mask, who had just broken a window and gained entry to the Fort Bragg Food Bank located at 910 N. Franklin Street.

Upon arrival, officers observed a broken window at the front of the location, and upon closer inspection, observed the male suspect (Lance Louis Hanberg Jr.) inside. Officers stated the suspect was wearing a black mask over his eyes and nose, and when told to stop and show his hands, fled to the rear interior of the business to hide.

MCSO Deputies arrived to assist, and a perimeter was set up to secure the building until officers could gain access and search for the suspect. Once the officers gained entry to the building, a search for the suspect was conducted. The suspect was located hiding on top of a large shelving rack, and had covered himself with packaging material.

The suspect was taken into custody without incident, and was later identified to be on CDC (California Department of Corrections) parole for prior burglary charges.

When questioned about why he had entered the structure, the suspect stated he was looking for a warm, dry place to sleep. When asked about the mask he was seen wearing, the suspect stated he did not want anyone to know who he was.

The suspect was booked and transported to Mendocino County Jail for multiple charges, and violation of parole terms.
