Hello,

I attended the last meeting of the Planning Commission in which the public was offered an opportunity to comment. Most of the folks commenting were Todd Point neighbors who seemed to voice some variation of the same theme, "not in my back yard".

I attempted to offer a comment too but being at the tail end public comment period, with the need of the Commission to move along, not sure my thoughts were well articulated. So thought I would send a short note to reiterate.

As I think most folks who have been here a while would agree, there is a lot of activity (vehicle and pedestrian traffic) along Highway 1 South of Hare Creek bridge to Simpson Lane and to al lesser extent to Boyce Lane. Pedestrian accommodations from Noyo Bridge South are lacking or non-existent. This poses challenges for one waking or riding a bike and can be down right dangerous

Unfortunately the forethought I am advocating, **providing a side walk along the entire frontage of this land**, was not taken into account at the time the Boatyard Center was developed. Let's not make this same mistake again. This does not address the entire issue but it is a start.
