CIRCUMSTANCES

On Wednesday, January 30, 2008 at approximately 8:39 PM Fort Bragg Police Officers were dispatched to Century 21 for a report of glass breaking in the area. Barry Daust an employee of the Century 21 contacted dispatch and told them he heard glass breaking at the location and believed the location was being burglarized. Daust locked himself inside of an upstairs office. He continued to speak with dispatch. Officers immediately responded to the location and set a perimeter. Daust told dispatch he heard someone at the location. Officers approached the building to apprehend the suspect.

As Officers approached the building Daust told dispatch the suspect was running down the stairs to exit the building. Officers contacted the suspect as he attempted to flee the building through the front door. The suspect known to the Officers as Anthony Boyles wouldn't follow verbal commands as he exited the front door of Century 21. Boyles advanced on Sergeant Charles Gilchrist and was immediately taken to the ground. Officers Livermore and Gregory moved into position to take Boyles into custody. Livermore and Gregory struggled with Boyles as he continued to resist arrest. Officers Livermore and Gregory were able to get Boyles into handcuffs and secure the scene. Officer Gregory maintained custody of Boyles while Sergeant Gilchrist and Livermore searched the building to determine if there were any further suspects at the location.

Daust was located safe in the upstairs office and he was escorted to a safe location downstairs so an investigation could be conducted. Sergeant Lee and Officer Pimentel arrived at the location and took custody of Boyles. Property from the Century 21 was located in Boyles possession.

Boyles was held in custody and subsequently transported to Mendocino County Jail in Ukiah pending arraignment on charges of 459 PC Burglary and 496 PC, Possession of Stolen Property.
