MAPLE STREET STORM DRAIN AND ALLEYS REHABILITATION PROJECT KICK-OFF

A contract with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. for the 2020 Maple Street Rehabilitation Project design was approved by City Council on December 6, 2019, and is set to Kick-off this week. The design portion of the project includes surveying and geotechnical investigations in six different locations across town. The locations include the eastern most section of Maple Street from S. Harold Street to Lincoln Street and five alleys, shown in the image below.

Crews from R.E.Y. Engineers and Geocon Consultants will be performing surface and subsurface exploration in these areas to gather data for the Rehabilitation Project. The work will be performed from January 29th through the 31st, between 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Portions of subject alleys and Maple Street may be temporarily blocked for up to an hour while work is performed and there will be no parking in these locations during the exploration. "No Parking" signs will be deployed over the course of the next day within these locations. Please observe all signage and traffic controls so that data can be collected efficiently and accurately. The crew will strive to maintain vehicular access to public and private areas. Your patience is greatly appreciated.
