### **CIRCUMSTANCES:**

On April 1, 2020 at approximately 1:57 pm, Fort Bragg Officers were dispatched to a stabbing in the 100 block of Minnesota Ave. The 911 caller reported to police dispatch that he had just stabbed the VICTIM.

Officers responded and found the VICTIM with a stab wound to the neck. The suspect, Shiloh Alonso, was near the scene. Fort Bragg Police detained Shiloh and began providing life saving medial aid to the VICTIM. Mendocino Coast Ambulance arrived and provided further medical aid to stabilize the VICTIM. Coast Ambulance met directly with a REACH helicopter to airlift the VICTIM to a trauma hospital in Sonoma County.

Fort Bragg Police continued with an investigation of the scene to determine what circumstances lead to this violent assault. Alonso was booked at Fort Bragg Police Station on numerous criminal charges and was then transported to the Mendocino County Jail.
