#### **CIRCUMSTANCES:**

On July 14, 2015 at approximately 10:20 a.m., Fort Bragg Police Officers were dispatched to the 400 block of N. Main Street for a report of a hit and run collision. Upon arrival, officers were provided with a note that was located on the victim's vehicle stating it had been struck. The note had been written by a witness to the collision and contained a description of the suspect vehicle and its license plate number. Upon inspection of the victim's vehicle officers did locate damage.

While investigating the call for service the victim's co-worker re-contacted the Police Department and advised they had located the vehicle at 490 S. Main Street in Fort Bragg. Officers responded and located the vehicle and its driver, who was identified as Lyra Star Mist Jubb of Fort Bragg. During the investigation it was determined Jubb was also displaying a false license plate on her vehicle. Jubb was subsequently arrested for fleeing the scene of a collision, displaying a false license plate, and obstructing an investigation. Jubb was transported to the Mendocino County Adult Detention Facility in Ukiah, CA.
