#### **CIRCUMSTANCES:**

On September 3, 2015, Fort Bragg police officers responded with lights and siren to the report of a vehicle colliding with a pedestrian in the intersection of Redwood Avenue and N. Main Street. On scene, officers located a 17 year old female who had sustained minor injuries during the collision. The female and other witnesses on scene identified the driver of the vehicle as Stephen Anapolsky, and stated that Anapolsky had fled the scene after providing his name.

At approximately 5:11 p.m., officers located Anapolsky at the Mendocino Coast District Hospital and noted that he was displaying signs and symptoms of being under the influence of a controlled substance. Officers administered a series of tests which showed that Anapolsky was likely under the influence of a controlled substance and he was subsequently arrested after admitting to being the driver at the time of the collision.

Anapolsky was charged with 20001(b) VC (Hit-and-Run with Injury), 23152(c) VC (Narcotic Addict Operating a Vehicle), 23152(e) VC (Driving under the Influence of Drugs), 23153(e) VC (DUI causing Injury) and 1203.2 PC (Violation of Probation). Anapolsky was transported to Mendocino County Adult Detention Facility where he posted bail and was released.
