CIRCUMSTANCES:

On November 2, 2015, at approximately 5:50 p.m., Officers of the Fort Bragg Police Department were dispatched to 1000 block of N. Main Street (the Pudding Creek Bridge), for the report of a traffic collision involving a vehicle and bicyclist. Upon arrival, officers discovered that the victim bicyclist had walked to Nello’s Market, requesting assistance. The victim advised that he was riding his bicycle northbound across the Pudding Creek Bridge, and was struck by a passing vehicle and thrown from his bicycle to the roadway. The victim had a complaint of severe shoulder pain, and was provided a ride by officers to the emergency room, where he was treated and later released.

The victim was unable to describe the suspect vehicle or driver, and appeared extremely shaken by the event. A passing motorist and witness following the suspect vehicle was only able to describe the suspect vehicle as a white pickup truck. No other information was provided.
