CIRCUMSTANCES:

On March 18, 2016, Gilbert Chambers reported that he received a letter in the mail on March 7, 2016 from the Numerological Resource Center Analysis Division, claiming he was to be the recipient of \$2,150,000.00.

Chambers called the number provided in the letter and was instructed to send the company \$1,250.00. Between March 7, 2016 and March 18, 2016 Chambers sent \$9,250.00 to several different locations in an attempt to collect the \$2,150,000.00 he had been notified of winning.

The Fort Bragg Police Department would like to caution the community regarding requests for money for "prizes" allegedly won. Even if you have entered a sweepstakes or raffle, do not provide money to anyone. You should never have to pay to receive any prizes won. The public is encouraged to contact the Fort Bragg Police Department at 707-964-0200 for assistance in investigating any suspicious mail or telephone notification of "prizes" won, especially if money is being requested.
