CIRCUMSTANCES:

On July 6, 2016 at approximately 10:25 P.M., officers from the Fort Bragg Police Department responded to a report of a party, where juveniles were believed to be consuming alcohol, in the 200 Block of S. Main Street in Fort Bragg.

Upon arrival, officers contacted several adults (see listed suspects), juveniles, and located several containers of alcohol at the location. The adults on scene were arrested, cited, and released for contributing to the delinquency of the minors. The person in control of the location was cited for violation of the social host ordinance in addition to contributing to the delinquency of the minors. The juveniles on scene were arrested, cited, and released to their parents or responsible party, for violation of the City of Fort Bragg's social host ordinance.

While on scene, two juveniles fled from officers. They have been identified, and additional charges have been filed with the juvenile courts.

The Fort Bragg Police Department would like to remind everyone that allowing juveniles to host a party involving alcohol at their residence, or on property within their control, could result in their arrest. Also, per section

9.78.030 of the Fort Bragg Municipal Code, the property owner, or persons responsible for the location, regardless if they are present, or any persons at the location, could be held accountable for the violations occurring.
