CIRCUMSTANCES: Halloween Safety

On Tuesday, October 31, 2017 Wall Street will be closed between Oak Street and Chestnut Street from 6:00pm to 9:00pm at the request of several neighbors on Wall Street and after consideration by the Fort Bragg Police Department. This closure is due to the safety concerns for the ever increasing foot traffic on Wall Street and to provide a safe, traffic free street for trick or treating.

The Fort Bragg Police Department would like to remind parents of a few safety tips for Halloween. Carry a flashlight while escorting your children and consider wearing a reflective vest for visibility. Watch your child at all times, and do not allow them to run ahead of you or cross streets without you.

At the end of the night and prior to eating the treats collected, inspect them, looking for items or things that could be harmful.

The Fort Bragg Police Department would also like to ask those traveling in vehicles on this date to slow down and be extra careful when driving due to the children and increased foot traffic along our roadways.

As a reminder, PAL will be hosting their annual Halloween Party at the Firehouse on Main Street from 5:00pm to 7:00pm. Be sure to come by for fun, free games and activities for the kids such as Halloween crafts and cookie decorating!
