CIRCUMSTANCES:

On January 30, 2018 the Fort Bragg Police Department released information to the public about a suspect wanted in the burglary at Redwood Elementary School. The burglary took place between January 26, 2018 and January 29, 2018 and one suspect had been arrested. An additional suspect, Jordan Broyles, was identified in the investigation.

On January 31, 2018 at approximately 3:30 p.m., Officers from the Fort Bragg Police Department received information that Jordan Broyles was in the east parking lot of Safeway. Officers were told that Broyles was wearing a gray sweatshirt and was riding a black BMX bicycle.

Officers arrived at the location and observed a subject matching the description. Officers contacted the subject, confirmed it was Broyles and placed him under arrest. Broyles was then transported to the Fort Bragg Police Department for questioning. Broyles was then booked and transported to the Mendocino County Jail.
