### **CIRCUMSTANCES:**

On March 2, 2018, at 11:56 PM, Officers observed a black BMW convertible traveling south bound in the 500 block of S. Main Street without its headlights illuminated. Officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle for the observed violation. During the stop, it was determined the vehicle had been reported stolen out of Napa County.

The four juvenile occupants were detained and an investigation was initiated. The female juvenile driver, 17 years of age, out of Sonoma, was subsequently placed under arrest for being in possession of a stolen vehicle and was transported to Mendocino County Juvenile Hall. The three juvenile passengers were later released to their families.
