2019 STREETS REHABILITATION PROJECT UPDATE

Work begins Monday September 23, 2019 for the 2019 Streets Rehabilitation project that includes reconstruction of 17 short street segments. The project is expected to be completed by year's end. This first phase of construction includes only replacement of concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk in strategically selected locations on the following streets: Myrtle, Woodward, Spring, Halsey, N. Harold, N. Harrison and Olsen.

Concrete excavation, demolition and forming for the sidewalk upgrades will occur Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. In addition, the landscaped roundabout at the intersection of E. Fir and N. Harrison will also be removed. Residents along the affected roadways will be notified 48 hours prior to work and No Parking signs will be placed 72 hours prior to work in those affected areas.

Drivers are reminded to allow additional driving time, to drive cautiously in the construction zones, and encouraged to park and use nearby streets. Road construction projects by their nature, can cause minor inconveniences to residents on impacted roads. The City and the contractors are working diligently to minimize those concerns. It is our hope that the benefits afforded by these street improvements outweigh the temporary inconveniences caused by construction.
