### STORM DRAIN MARKERS TO BE INSTALLED

Only rain down the drain curb markers will be replaced/installed on all City Storm Drain inlets as a friendly reminder to educate the public that anything other than rain water in the storm drain system has the potential to pollute our waterways. These medallions serve as a visual reminder to the public that there is no pre-treatment for storm water prior to its release into local waterways.

Conservation Corps North Bay volunteers will be affixing \*No Dumping \*Drains to Ocean\* or \*Drains to River\* medallions on Thursday, October 10 and Friday, October 11 throughout the City. The Corps volunteers will be wearing safety vests, but many of these inlets are in the traveled way, so we ask motorists to drive carefully in the vicinity near volunteers. The Conservations Corps receives funding from CalRecycle to host events like this in communities across the north state.
