CIRCUMSTANCES:

On October 8, 2019 Officers of the Fort Bragg Police Department were contacted in the front lobby for a report of someone sleeping outside of the old Social Services Building, located at 825 S. Franklin Street. Officers responded to the location and located a female who was immediately recognized by Officers due to prior contacts.

As Officers approached her, they noticed that she had delayed respirations, and had blood coming from her nose and mouth. Officers checked for a pulse, and found that she did not have a pulse. Officers immediately began CPR and requested an ambulance respond to their location. Officers had an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) with them, and deployed it.

A short time later members from the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office, the Fort Bragg Fire Department, and Paramedics from Coast Hospital arrived to assist. The victim was stabilized at the scene and transported via ambulance to the Mendocino Coast District Hospital, where she was later flown out to Santa Rosa Memorial Hospital.
