Circumstances: On March 1, 2013 at approximately 11:43 a.m., Officers of the Fort Bragg Police Department were dispatched to 140 E. Oak Street for a report of a domestic violence assault in progress. Reporting parties advised that the female had been stabbed in the face multiple times.

Upon arrival, officers discovered that the female had not been stabbed, but had been physically assaulted by her brother, Timothy McNeill, during an argument between the two. McNeill was alleged to be hiding inside the apartment building, and officers conducted a complete search of the building. McNeill was believed to have fled the area, and officers began searching the surrounding areas. The victim was transported by ambulance to the Mendocino Coast District Hospital for treatment of her injuries.

Officers continued to search the area for McNeill, and located him in front of the CVS Pharmacy located at 150 S. Main Street minutes later. McNeill was taken into custody without further incident, and was booked for battery on a person causing injury. McNeill was later transported to the Mendocino County Adult Detention Facility in Ukiah.
