**Circumstances:** On March 14, 2013, at approximately 2:06 a.m., Officers of the Fort Bragg Police Department were dispatched to 415 S. McPherson Street Apt. 8, for a report of a domestic violence assault. Upon arrival, officers determined that the victim had been struck in the head with a glass vase, causing an injury, while trying to leave the apartment of his ex-girlfriend, Guadalupe “Nataly” Cervera Perez.

Further investigation revealed that Cervera Perez had left her 10 month old child, whom the victim is the father of, alone and unsupervised in her apartment while she walked to the victim’s apartment and tried to persuade him to come back to her.

When the victim walked Cervera Perez back to her apartment a second time to check the welfare of their child, Cervera Perez struck the victim in the head with the vase to try and prevent him from leaving. Cervera Perez was arrested for domestic violence, assault with a deadly weapon, and endangering the safety of a child.

Cervera Perez was later transported to the Mendocino County Adult Detention Facility in Ukiah.
