

RESOLUTION NO. 3348-2010

RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH JOHNSON IT GROUP FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT (AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$22,800; ACCOUNT NO. 521-4394-0351)

WHEREAS, City staff conducted a search of a consultant firms to replace existing information technology (IT) consulting services; and

WHEREAS, staff identified Johnson IT Group as the firm most capable of providing the expected level of service for the City of Fort Bragg; and

WHEREAS, the Johnson IT Group has been commissioned to act as an interim service provider following the departure of the previous IT consultant and staff has found that Johnson IT Group provides a service level that exceeds expectations; and

WHEREAS, Johnson IT Group has prepared a Citywide IT audit and assessment; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$45,600 were appropriated in the FY 2009-10 Budget for IT services and sufficient funds are available for this contract; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

1. Johnson IT Group has completed an assessment of the City of Fort Bragg's system and has identified opportunities to enhance service levels and systems design and has provided recommendations to upgrade the IT capacity of the City; and
2. Johnson IT Group has the expertise and capacity necessary to provide contract services for maintenance and development of the City's IT services; and
3. Johnson IT Group has agreed to perform these services as defined in the Professional Services Agreement, Exhibit A-Scope of Work, in a professional and timely manner and within the fiscal constraints imposed by the City's budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby approve the Professional Services Agreement with Johnson IT Group for Information Technology Services and authorizes the City Manager to execute said Agreement (Amount not to exceed \$22,800; Account No. 521-4394-0351).

The above and foregoing Resolution was introduced by Councilmember Turner, seconded by Councilmember Gjerde, and passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg held on the 22nd day of February, 2010, by the following vote:

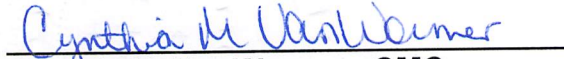
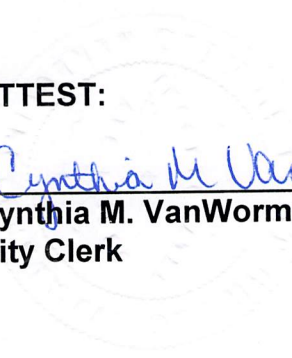
