**RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET (STATE ROUTE #1) FOR THE PAUL BUNYAN DAYS LABOR DAY PARADE (MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2006)**

**WHEREAS**, the Paul Bunyan Days Association is sponsoring a Labor Day Parade on Monday, September 4, 2006, said parade is to be conducted within the City of Fort Bragg as more particularly set forth in the attached Encroachment Permit Application marked as Exhibit "A;" and


**WHEREAS**, the Paul Bunyan Days Association has applied for a Parades/Celebrations permit, and

**WHEREAS**, the California Department of Transportation has required as part of their encroachment field permit process, that the Paul Bunyan Association obtain a Resolution from the City Council authorizing the closure of Main Street (State Route #1).


