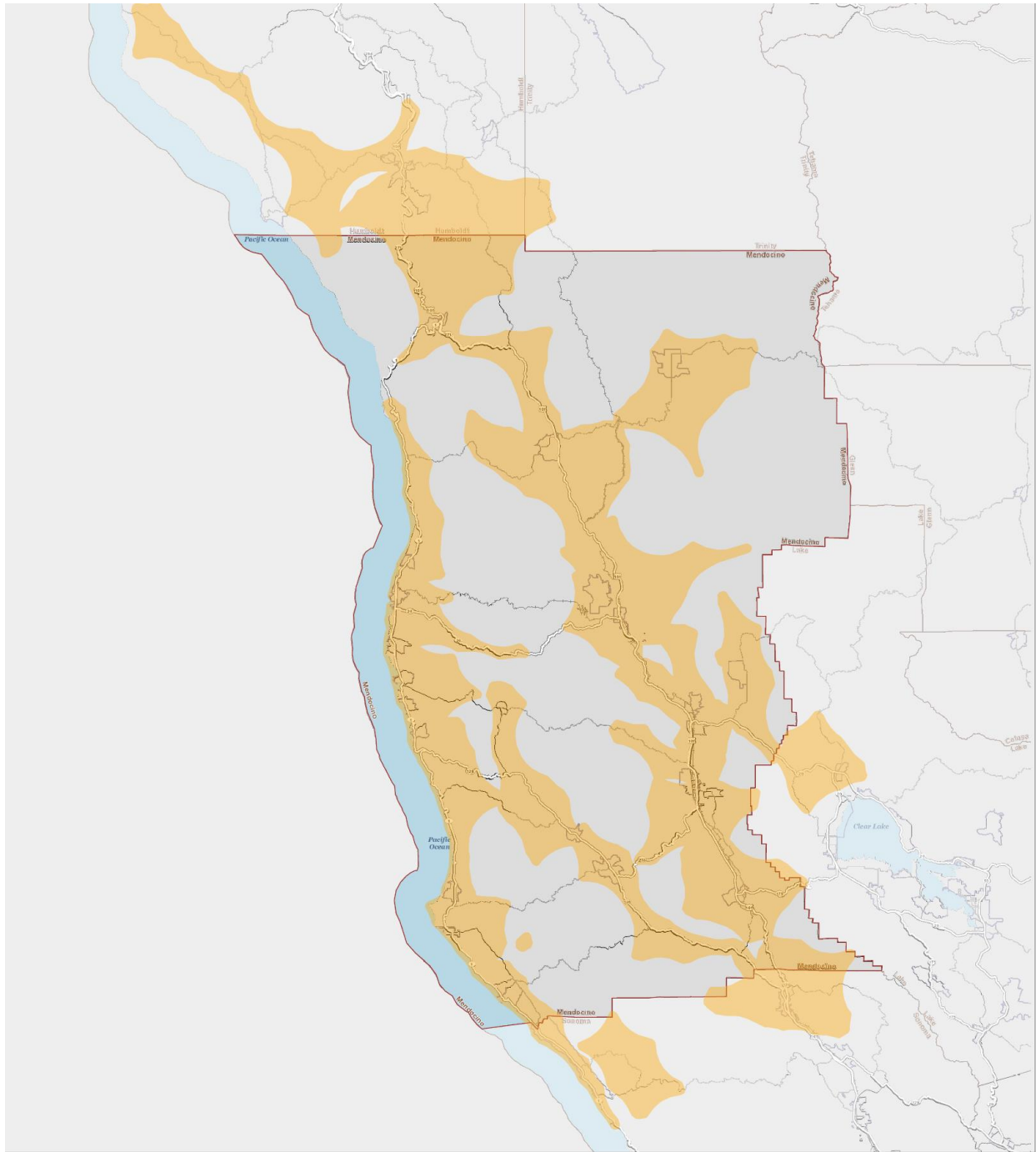
CIRCUMSTANCES: City staff has received confirmation of a Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) event that will impact the city of Fort Bragg. The PSPS will take place on 10/26/19. The City and most of Mendocino County will be impacted. Our updated information is that de-energization will be starting at approximately 5pm. Although PG&E may try to begin the restoration process on Sunday afternoon, you should prepare to be out of power for at least two days.

All residents are encouraged to have supplies on hand as well as lighting sources at their disposal. Essential functions such as water and public safety communications will be operating under back-up power sources.

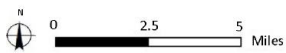
