### JULY 13, 2020

First date nomination papers will be issued.

### AUGUST 7, 2020 | BY 5PM

Last day to file nomination papers if any incumbent files.

### AUGUST 12, 2020 | BY 5PM

Last day to file nomination papers if any incumbent fails to file.

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## QUALIFICATIONS

A person is eligible to serve on the City Council only if he/she meets the following requirements at the time nomination papers are issued.

**All candidates must be:**

- At least 18 years of age at the time of election
- A citizen of the state at the time of election
- A resident of Fort Bragg residing within the City Limits
- A registered voter and qualified to vote at the time nomination papers are issued
- Not convicted of designated crimes as specified in the Constitution and laws of the state

## PURPOSE OF ELECTION

There are two Council member positions to be filled by this election. The incumbents are: William V. Lee and Bernie Norvell.

## FILING FEE

There is no filing fee.

## DOCUMENT FILING

Nomination papers are issued by and must be filed with the City Clerk, 416 N. Franklin Street, Fort Bragg.

## NOMINATION PACKAGE

The Nomination Package consists of the following documents. The listed bulleted items must be returned to the City Clerk by the filing deadline (*see reverse*).

At least 20, but no more than 30, valid signatures are required for nomination. A signature is valid if the person is a registered voter living within the City Limits of Fort Bragg.

The City pays all costs of candidate statements in English and Spanish to be published in the voter pamphlet. (*Optional*)
- **Code of Fair Campaign Practices (Optional)**

- **Political sign regulations**
- **Public records request form**
