(7) IMPORTANT MANDATORY ACTIONS TO CONSERVE WATER

1). The reduction of water consumption by 20%

2). Lawn and esthetic landscape irrigation is prohibited (The irrigation of crop and plant gardens are exempt)

3). The following actions are prohibited:

- a. Irrigation runoff
- b. Water hose usage without a shut-off nozzle
- c. Washing of driveways, sidewalks, etc.
- d. Water use for non-recirculating fountains
- e. Garden irrigation within 48 hours after rainfall
- f. Garden irrigation between 10am and 6pm
- g. Serving drinking water other than when requested
- h. Irrigation outside newly constructed homes and buildings inconsistent with CA Building Standards Commission and the Department of HCD

4). The following uses are prohibited:

- a. Washing of any exterior surface of any building
- b. Filling or refilling a new or existing swimming pool
- c. Compaction or dust control usage for construction projects without previous City approval
- d. The use of any broken watering device

5). Hotels shall provide guests options to re-use towels and linens daily

6). Tampering with any portion of the water system to circumvent the required conservation measures is prohibited

7). Residential and commercial water leaks shall be repaired as soon as possible, but no later than 5 days after notification by the City



The violation of any of the actions listed as per Fort Bragg Municipal Code Section 14.06.050 Conservation Goals and Prohibited Water Uses During Water Emergency may result in a fine as determined in the City of Fort Bragg Fee Schedule
