



CITY OF FORT BRAGG STAGE 3 WATER EMERGENCY PLEASE CONSERVE!!!

THE FOLLOWING USES OF WATER ARE PROHIBITED:

1. Defective or leaking equipment using City water must be repaired or turned off.
2. Irrigation or watering of landscaping with City water is prohibited.
3. Washing/cleaning of any paved surfaces and building exteriors is prohibited.
4. Vehicles may only be washed at a carwash or with a hose fitted with a shut-off nozzle.
5. Restaurants may only serve water upon specific request. Use of disposable plates, cups and flatware is required.
6. Lodging businesses must reduce their water usage and are encouraged to launder on a limited basis.
7. All commercial water customers are encouraged to be innovative in finding water reductions.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE CITY'S WATER SUPPLY:

- City water remains fully compliant with all health standards and is safe to drink. Taste, odor, and appearance may be affected.
- People with medical conditions that require managing salt intake may wish to use bottled water for drinking and cooking during this water emergency.
- We ask the community to work together to substantially reduce water usage until the winter rains improve our water supply.
