### CHESTNUT STREET CORRIDOR PROJECT UPDATE

Construction on the Chestnut Street Corridor Project is scheduled to begin next week. The work will take place one or two blocks at a time. Work will begin at the Chestnut Street/Dana Street intersection near Fort Bragg High School and will continue to the west (downhill). As much construction as possible will take place next to the three school sites on Chestnut Street during the winter break to minimize impacts when school is in session.

During construction, parking will not be available on either side of the street. Travel lanes will be kept open at all times. Re-alignment of the center line will take place as construction starts in each affected block. The lane shift will progress downhill as construction moves along. On-street parking will be restored (but shifted to the north side of the street) when the work on each block is completed.

Work hours are Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate the patience of residents on Chestnut Street and others travelling along the corridor.

Regular press releases will be issued to provide updates throughout the construction period. Several communication strategies will be employed, including: A Facebook page has been established to provide updates and responses to questions and concerns called "Chestnut Street Corridor."
