

## **RESOLUTION NO. 3768-2015**

### **RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL APPROVING USE OF FUNDING FROM THE 2014 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR A PUBLIC FACILITIES ACQUISITION AND REHABILITATION PROJECT ON BEHALF OF MENDOCINO COAST HOSPITALITY CENTER TO BE LOCATED AT 101 NORTH FRANKLIN STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Bragg held a Design Phase Public Hearing on January 7, 2014, to provide information about the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and to solicit input from the community as to suggestions about possible uses of grant funds from the 2014 CDBG allocations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fort Bragg City Council met in open session on February 24, 2014, to review community suggestions and needs and to recommend priorities for the 2014 CDBG grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, at their February 24, 2014, meeting, the City Council identified the several high priority activities that should be included in the 2014 CDBG application, including a Public Facility Acquisition and Rehabilitation Project at 300 North Harrison Street from the Community Development Allocation; and

**WHEREAS**, at their March 24, 2014, meeting after determining that federal citizen participation requirements were met during the development of the application through a Public Hearing before the City Council on March 24, 2014, the City Council approved a 2014 application for up to \$2,000,000 and execution of a grant agreement and any amendments thereto from the economic development and community development allocations of the State CDBG program; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2014 application included up to \$1,162,691 for a Public Facility Acquisition and Rehabilitation Project at 300 North Harrison Street; and

**WHEREAS**, an alternative location for the Public Facility Acquisition and Rehabilitation Project as funded from the 2014 CDBG grant has been proposed for 101 North Franklin Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that federal citizen participation requirements were met during the development of this application through a Public Hearing before the City Council on January 12, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds, based on information provided at the time of consideration of this matter, that the foregoing Recitals are true and correct.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby approve use of funding from the 2014 Community Development Block Grant for a project located at 101 North Franklin Street.

**The above and foregoing Resolution was introduced by Councilmember Hammerstrom, seconded by Councilmember Detiz, and passed and adopted at a regular**


