## GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. It is understood and agreed by the permittee that the installation of street furniture under the permit shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions, terms, conditions and /or restrictions of this permit.
2. The permit shall be kept at the site of the street furniture and must be shown to any representative of the grantor or any law enforcement officer upon demand.
3. PUBLIC CONVENIENCE - Permittee shall so place street furniture in a location that allows for adequate egress according to the Americans with Disabilities Act. A minimum clearance of 4' is required for pedestrian egress through all public rights of ways.
4. All street furniture shall conform to City approved standards and those specifications prescribed on the face of permit. Installations shall be done subject to the supervision of, and to the satisfaction of, the grantor.
5. INSPECTION REQUIRED - Following installation as authorized by the permit, the permittee shall request an inspection from the Engineering Technician at City Hall (707-961-2823).
6. NO ANCHORAGE TO PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY - Street furniture shall **not** be anchored to the public right-of-way.
7. It is understood by permittee that whenever construction, reconstruction, or maintenance work on the right of way may require the relocation of the street furniture provided for herein, it shall, upon request of the grantor, be immediately moved by and at the sole expense of the permittee.
8. LIABILITY FOR DAMAGES - Permittee is responsible for all liability for personal injury or property damage which may arise from the installed street furniture herein permitted, or may arise out of failure on the permittee's part to perform his obligations under the permit in respect to maintenance. In the event any claim of such liability is made against the City of Fort Bragg, or any department, officer, or employee, thereof, applicant shall defend, indemnify, and hold them and each of them harmless from such claim.

A FULLY EXECUTED COPY OF THIS APPLICATION SHALL CONSTITUTE A PERMIT
