## **RESOLUTION NO. 4374-2021**

## RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER OF A 20-FOOT-WIDE PUBLIC DRAINAGE EASEMENT FROM LYME REDWOOD TIMBERLANDS LLC

**WHEREAS,** there exists a storm drain pipe which conveys storm water along the Georgia Pacific Haul Road from its point of beginning on Cypress Street, conveying water in an easterly direction toward a large natural open channel then to the Noyo River; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is required to obtain access to portions of privately owned property where public infrastructure exists in order to maintain utilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the storm drain pipe lying within this property is scheduled for improvement as part of the Maple Street Storm Drain Rehabilitation Project which includes drainage from Alley S600 E off of Cypress Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the conveyance of the Public Storm Drain Easement will allow City and City Contractors to access, maintain, and improve the facilities now as part of the project and into perpetuity; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby:

- 1. Approve the conveyance of the 20-foot-wide Public Drainage Easement at AP# 018-080-55.
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to execute a Certificate of Acceptance for easement and direct the City Clerk to send same to the Mendocino County Recorder's Office for recording.
