The City of Fort Bragg, working in partnership with Sonoma State University, is having initial designs prepared for a marine science/education center for a portion of the Mill Site property. The proposed Noyo Center will serve as a cold water marine research center for the State college system and a nature center with marine exhibits and talks for residents and visitors. The City has hired the team of Bauer & Wiley and Jones & Jones to design the facility. These experienced architectural firms designed the Ocean Institute at Dana Point. The City is sponsoring two public design events for the community to inform the project design.
