
Please do your part to help conserve water.

Check your toilets.

Toilets are responsible for MOST indoor leaks.

To test for a leak, simply open the lid on the toilet tank and add a few drops of food coloring or a dye tablet. (City of Fort Bragg will provide FREE Toilet dye tablets) Don't flush the toilet -- instead, wait an hour or two without using the toilet at all. Afterward, check the water in the bowl. If the food coloring has seeped into the bowl, you know you have a leak.





Educate your guests!

1. Place "Table Tents" in Each Room. These are supplied by the City and alert visitors of the need to conserve water.

2. Yard Signs. City Hall also provides yard signs. Place yard signs at your site, reminding residents and guests to save water.

Additional Ways you can help conserve water:

BE AWARE OF LANDSCAPING RESTRICTIONS: Landscaping is allowed TUESDAYS ONLY from 12:00 a.m.—9:00 a.m. & 6:00 p.m.— 11:59 p.m.

PAY ATTENTION TO WATER OUTPUT and fix leaks right away.
