MESSAGE FROM FORT BRAGG MAYOR WILLIAM V. LEE

During this National Emergency, I want to express my gratitude for the goodness and kindness of the people of Fort Bragg. Difficult times, like we are now experiencing, make our community so special. We Fort Braggers always look out for each other in crises, and we offer comforting assistance to our friends and neighbors.

As we now face a mandatory Shelter-in-Place order from the Mendocino County Public Health Officer, we must all stay in our homes and venture out only for essential services or essential business. Essential businesses include going food shopping; picking up medications; doctor, dentist, and vet visits; and for essential exercise like walking, jogging or strolling on the beautiful Coastal Trail or in Otis Johnson Park. Walk with family but keep a six-foot distance from strangers as you exercise and get fresh air.

A mandatory Shelter-in-Place order is not meant to punish anyone, but to keep our families and friends safe during this pandemic. We encourage you to check in on elderly and sick/shut-in neighbors, but please call them first. You can offer to shop for them, to pick up their medications, or take them to their doctor visit or to the bank. You can make that large pot of soup, bake some bread, make your family-size lasagna and take it to those told to stay home.

Please support our local businesses during this crisis, as we are all in this together. Order take-out or home delivery from one of our fine restaurants (see attached list). Get essential supplies from one of our pharmacies or grocery stores. If you have questions or concerns, please call the County Public Health Office at (707) 234-6052. All Fort Bragg citizens, especially our local seniors, can contact the Fort Bragg Police Department at (707) 964-0200, and our officers and staff will direct you to the appropriate agency.

Also know that your City Council, the City Manager, and staff members are working hard to get ever-evolving information out to our citizens. Call any Council Member if you need help or more information. Together, looking out for each other, we will make it through this crisis in our City, our State and our Country.

MENSAJE DEL ALCALDE DE FORT BRAGG WILLIAM V. LEE

Durante esta emergencia nacional, quiero expresar mi gratitud por la bondad y amabilidad de la gente de Fort Bragg. Los tiempos difíciles como los que estamos viviendo ahora, hacen que nuestra comunidad sea tan especial. Nosotros siempre nos cuidamos unos a otros durante las crisis, y ofrecemos asistencia reconfortante a nuestros amigos y vecinos.

Como ahora nos enfrentamos a una orden obligatoria de Refugio en el Hogar por la Oficial de Salud Pública del Condado de Mendocino, todos debemos permanecer en nuestros hogares y salir solo para servicios o negocios esenciales. Los negocios esenciales incluyen ir de compras de alimentos; recoger medicamentos; visitas al médico, dentista y/o veterinario; y para ejercicios esenciales como caminar, o pasear por el hermoso sendero costero o en Otis Johnson Park. Caminen con sus familias, pero mantengan una distancia de seis pies entre extraños mientras hace ejercicio o toma aire fresco.

Una orden obligatoria de Refugio en su Hogar no está destinada a castigar a nadie, sino a mantener a nuestras familias y amigos a salvo durante esta pandemia. Podemos revisar como están nuestros vecinos ancianos o enfermos /aislados, pero por favor llámeles primero si es posible. Podemos ofrecer ir de compras por ellos, ofrecer recoger sus medicamentos o llevarlos a su visita al médico o al banco. También podemos hacer esa gran olla de sopa, hornear un poco de pan, cocinar una lasaña tamaño familiar y llevárselo a los que no pueden salir de sus casas.

Apoye a nuestros negocios locales durante esta crisis, ya que todos estamos juntos en esto. Pida comida para llevar o para entrega a domicilio en uno de nuestros excelentes restaurantes (vea la lista incluida). Obtenga necesidades esenciales de una de nuestras farmacias o supermercados locales. Si tienen preguntas o comentarios por favor llame al Departamento de Salud al (707) 234-6052. Todos los ciudadanos y especialmente personas mayores de Fort Bragg, pueden llamar al Departamento de Policía de Fort Bragg al (707) 964-0200 y nuestros oficiales y personal los dirigirán a agencias correspondiente.

También sepa que su Concilio Municipal, la manejadora de la Ciudad y los miembros del personal están trabajando arduamente para hacer llegar la información en constante evolución a nuestros ciudadanos.
