The County Elections Office has certified to the sufficiency of nomination papers for 5 candidates to fill two vacant four-year seats on the Fort Bragg City Council this November. The candidates are:

Incumbent Bernie Norvell will not be seeking reelection.

The last day to register to vote in the November 2024 election is October 21, 2024. You can register to vote online with the Secretary of State, <http://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/voter-registration/>, or in person at the Post Office and the Mendocino County Registrar of Voters office in Ukiah. Mail-in Voter Registration Application forms are also available at the Fort Bragg City Clerk's office at City Hall and the Fort Bragg Public Library. Sample Ballots will begin to be mailed out on September 26, 2024.

The election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
